

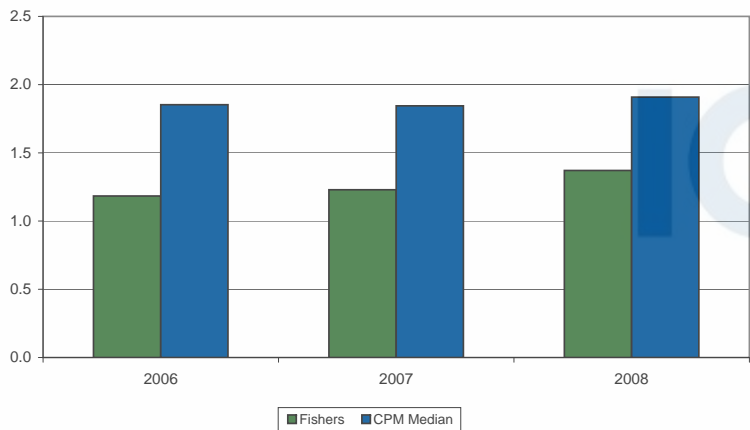

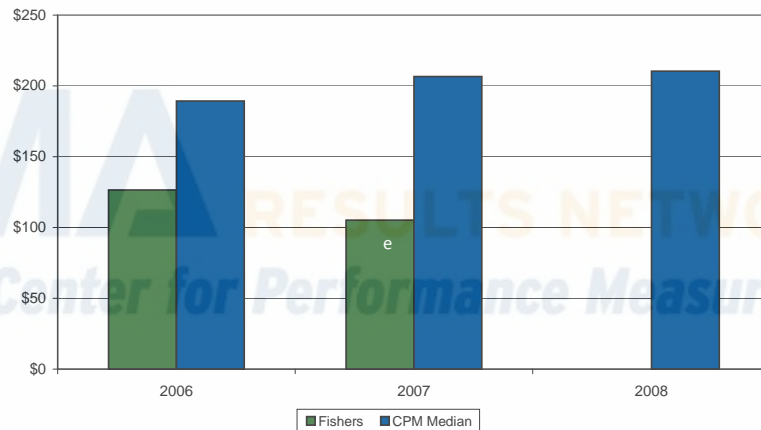

Number of Sworn Full Time Equivalents per 1,000 Population



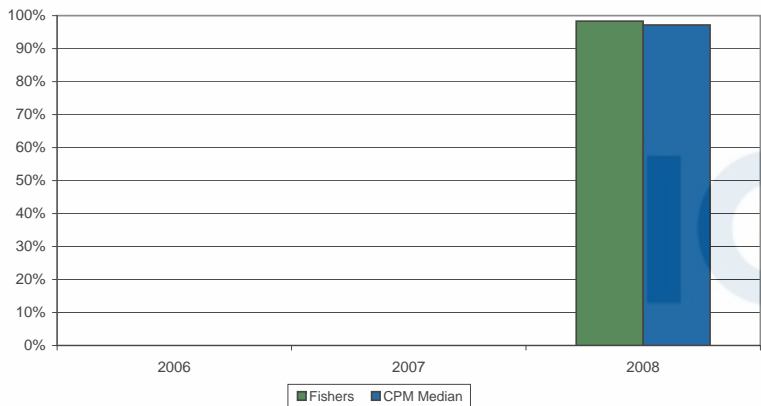
A 'Full Time Equivalent' is defined as the number of hours paid within the department divided by 2080.

Total Police Operation Expenditures Charged to the Police Department Per Capita



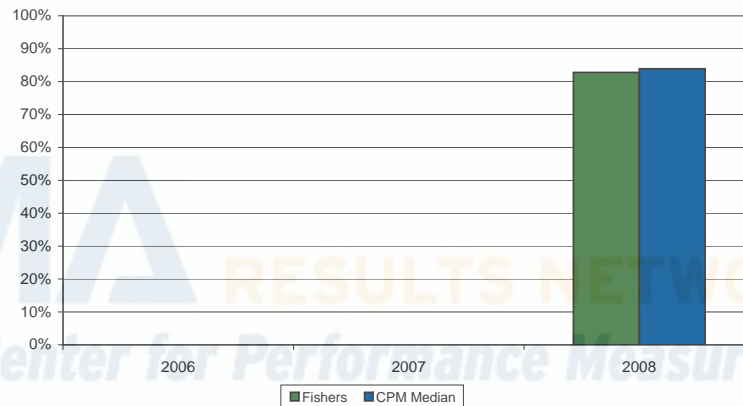
For FY 2007 Fishers reported \$6,868,811 in total police operation expenditures charged to the department.

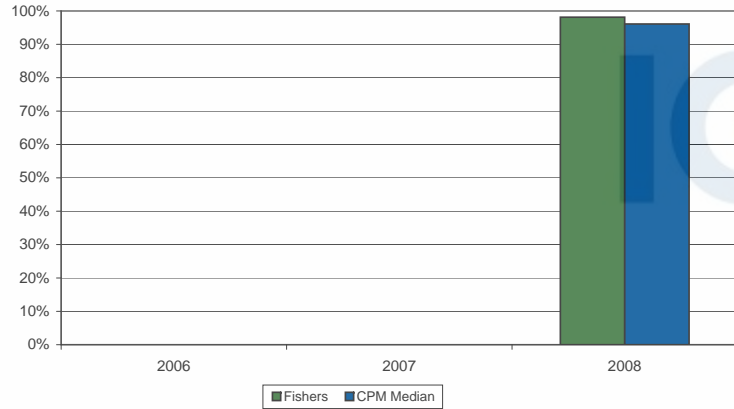
Citizen Rating of How Safe they Feel in Their Neighborhood at Night - Percentage Reporting Very or Somewhat Safe

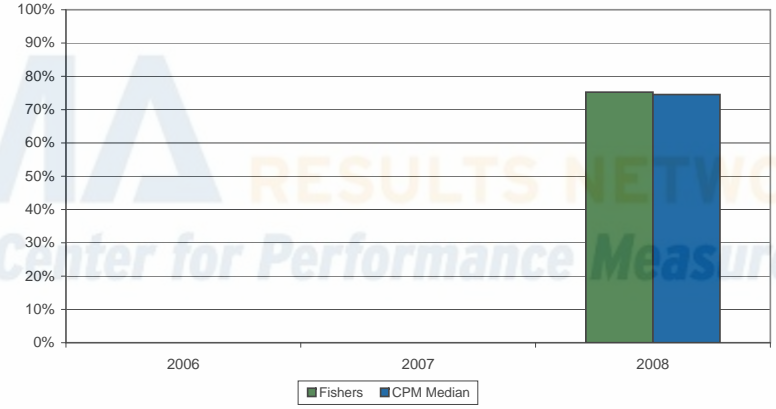

Citizen Rating of How Safe they Feel Alone in Business District During the Day - Percentage Reporting Very or Somewhat Safe



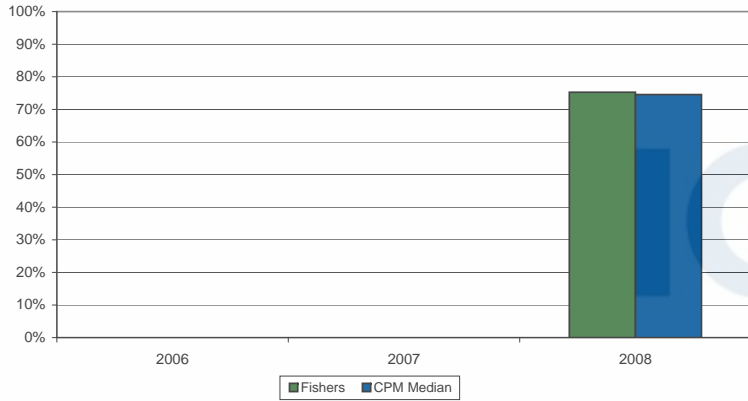

Citizen Rating of How Safe they Feel Alone in Business District at Night - Percentage Reporting Very or Somewhat Safe



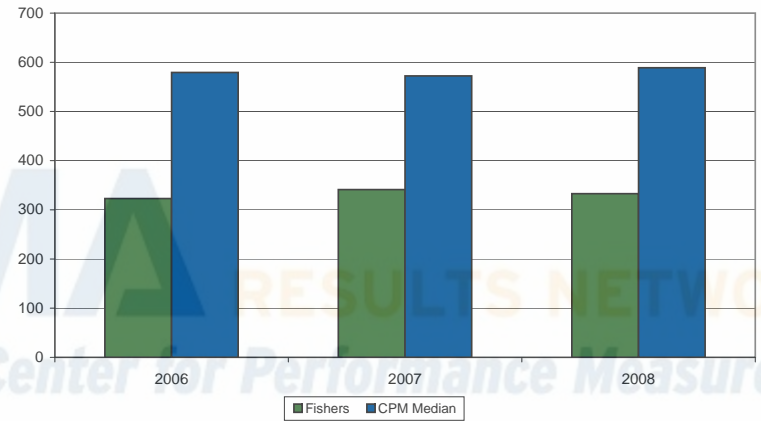

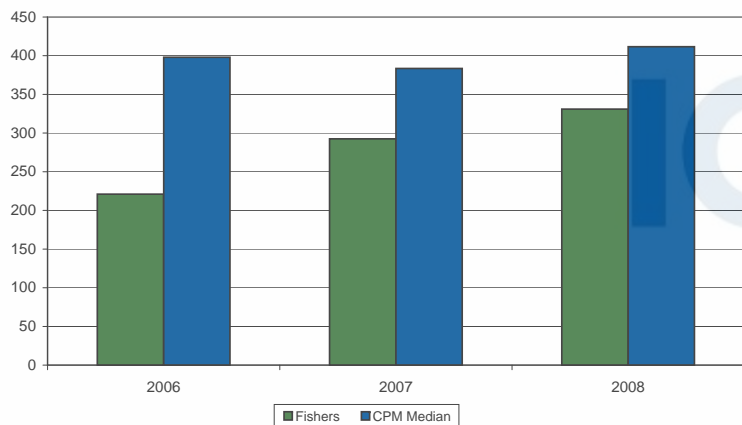

Number of Police Calls Resulting in a Dispatch per 1,000 Population

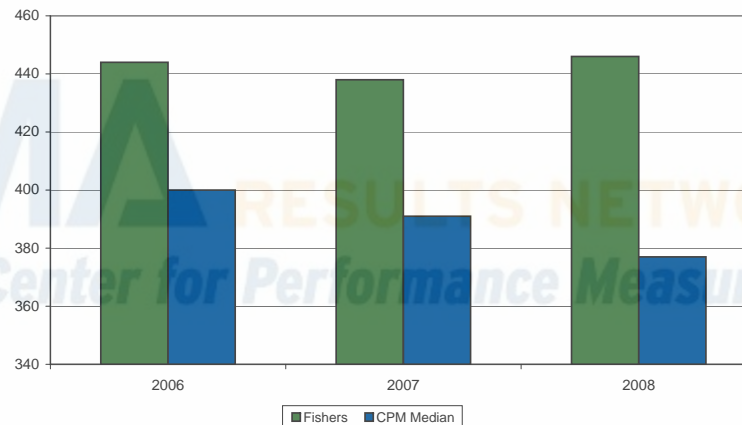

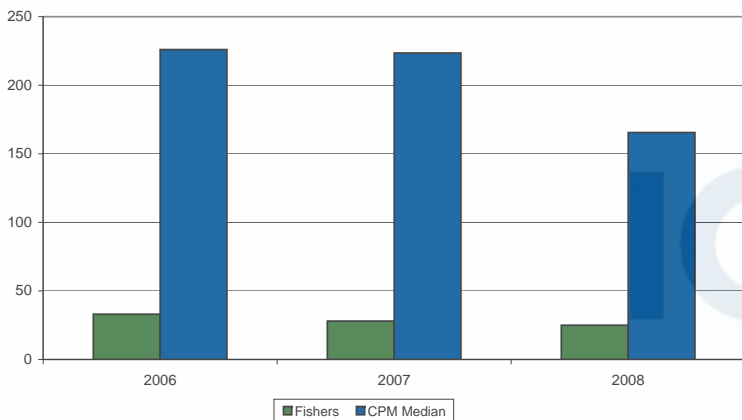
Total Number of Police Initiated Actions Resulting in a Dispatch per 1,000 Population



Tot Average Time from Receipt of Top Priority Calls to Arrival on Scene

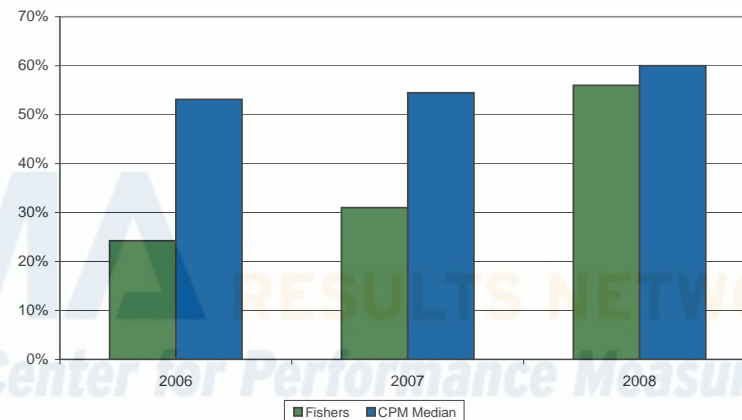


UCR\* Part I Violent Crimes Reported



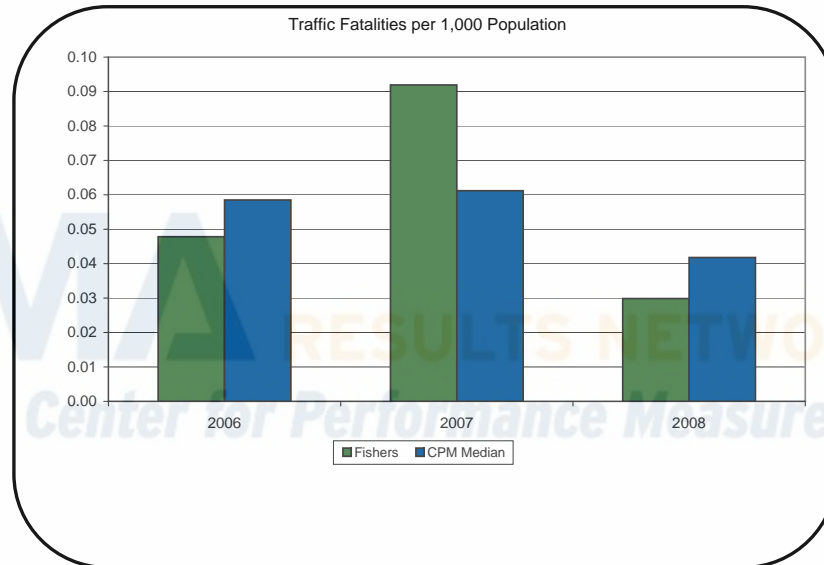
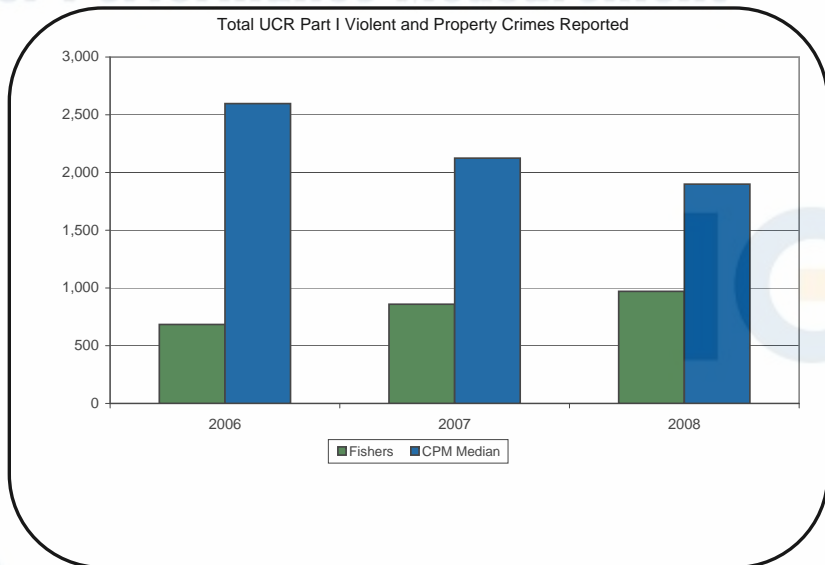
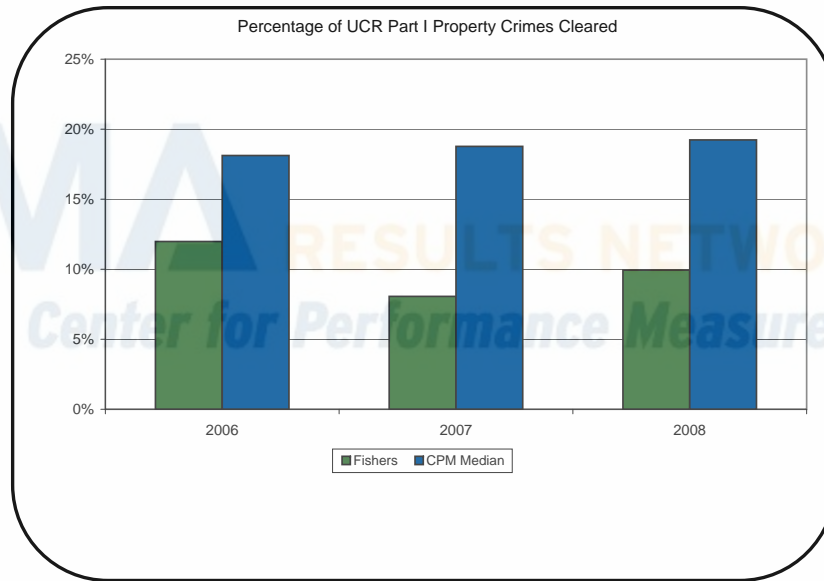
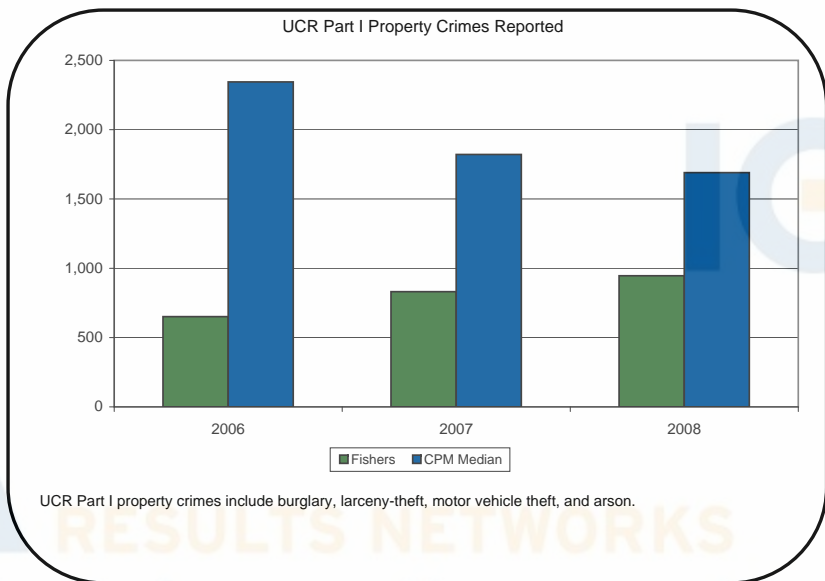

Percentage of UCR Part I Violent Crimes Cleared



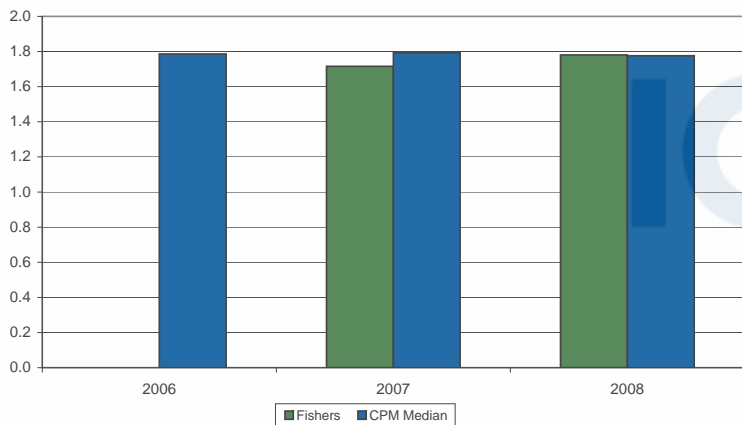
A crime is cleared when at least one person is arrested, charged with commission of the offense, and turned over to the court for prosecution.

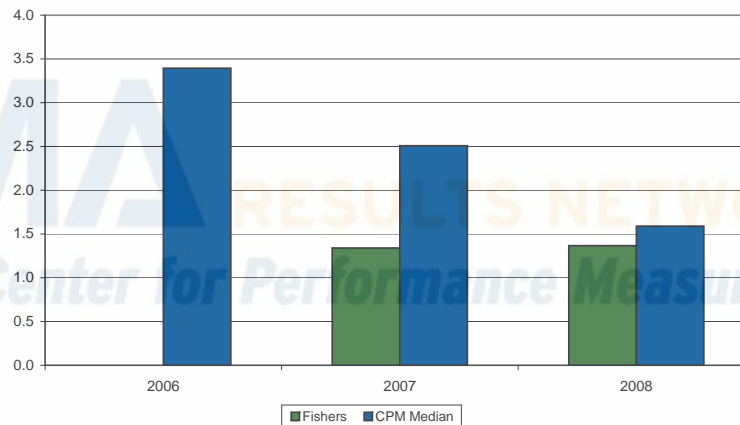

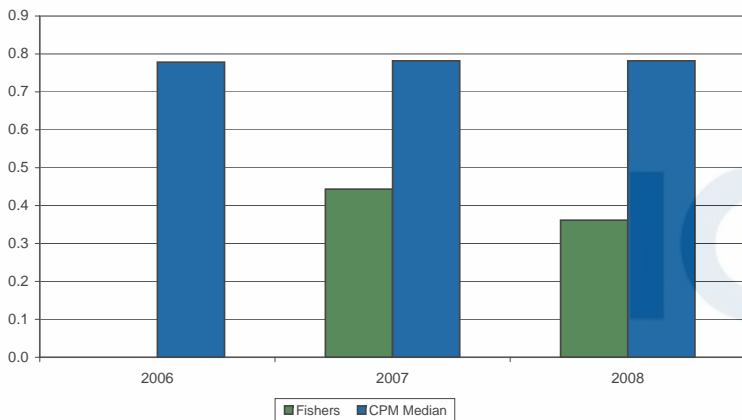
Civilian Full Time Equivalents for Fire and EMS



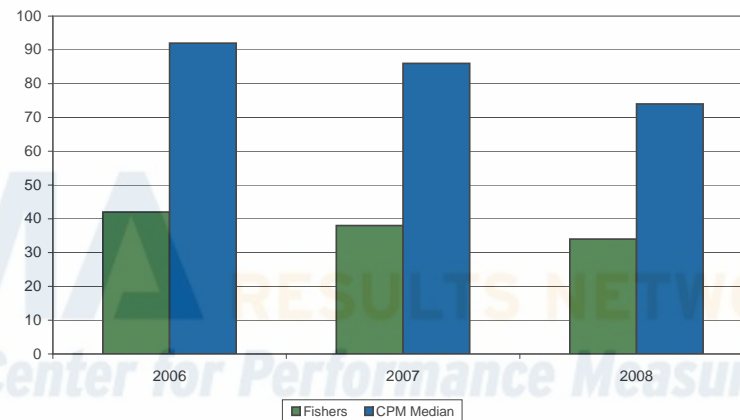
Residential Fire Incidents per 1,000 Residential Structures



Residential Fire Incidents per 1,000 Population

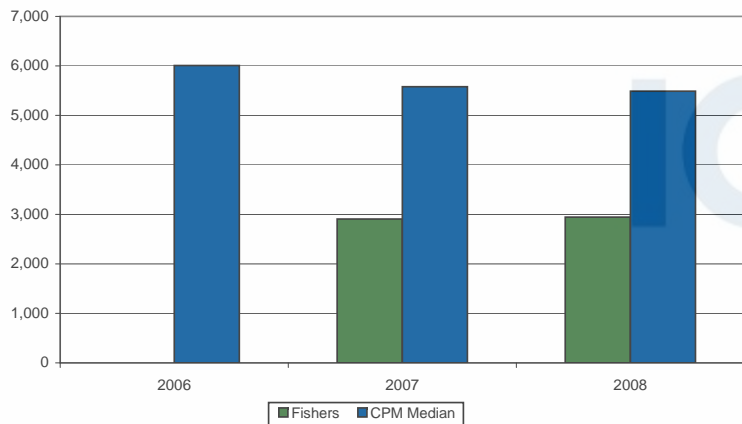

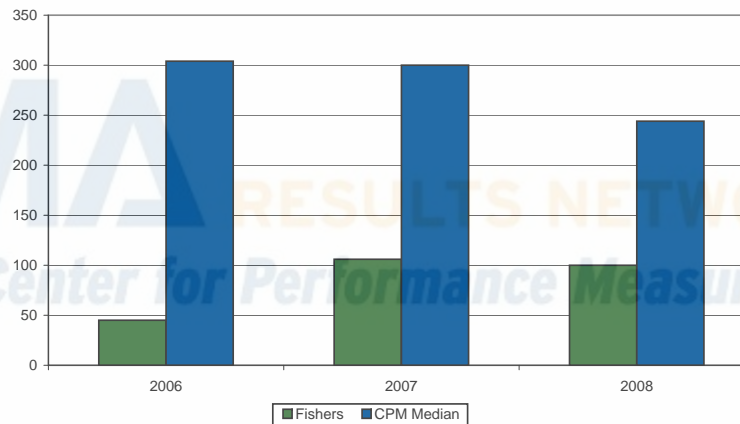

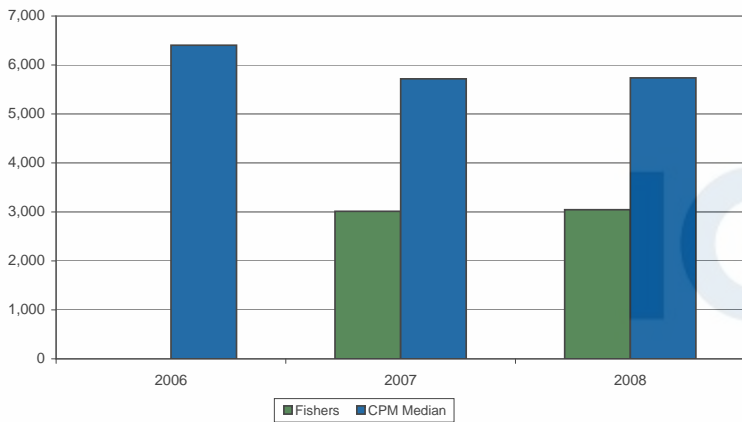
Total Number of Non-Fire Incidents that Require a Response



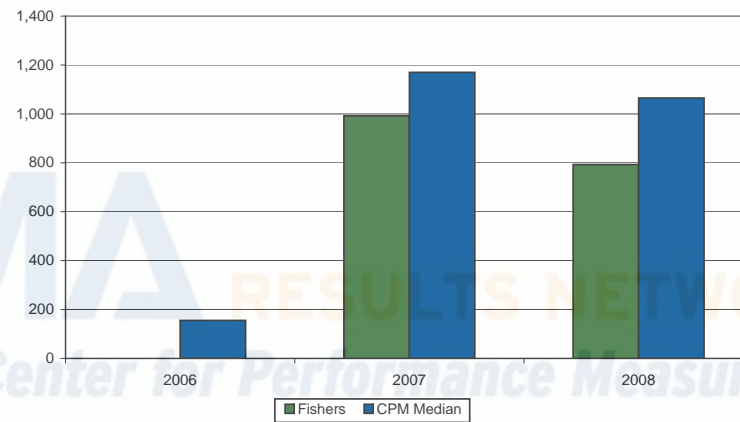
Total Number of Fire Incidents (Structure & Non-Structure)



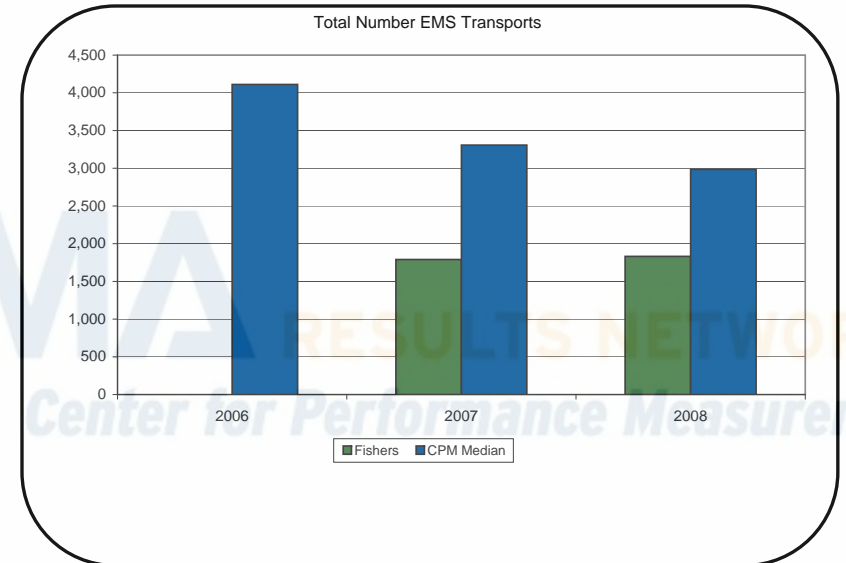
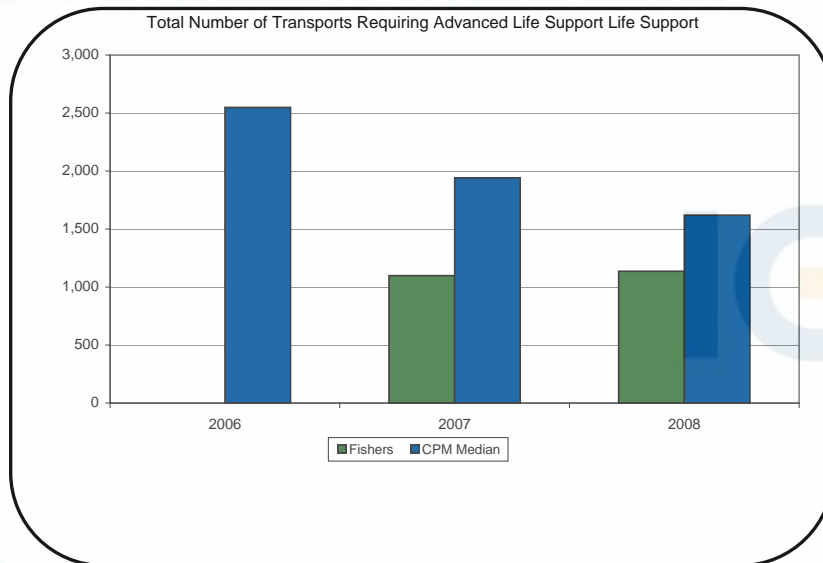
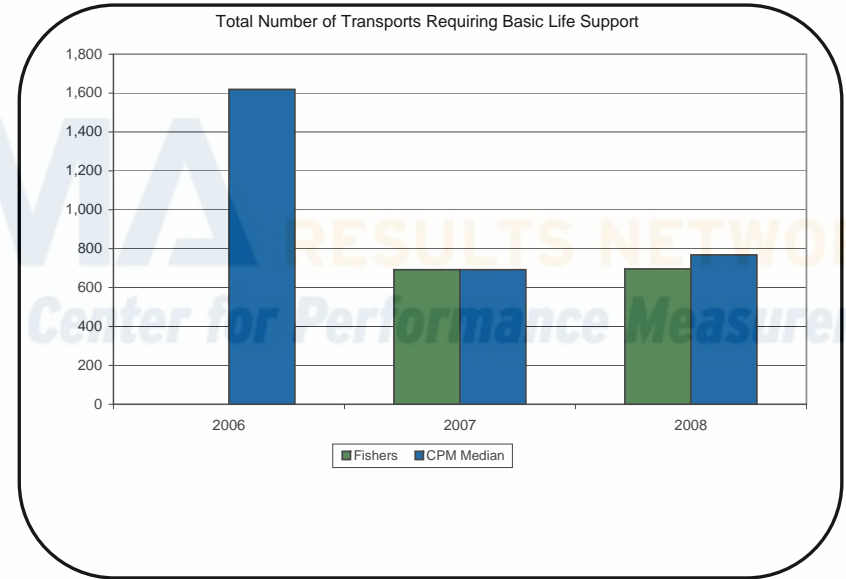
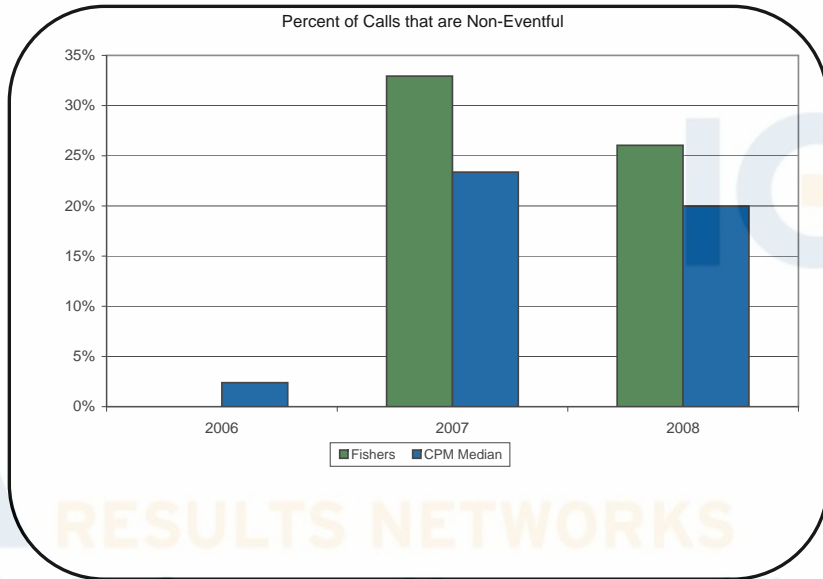
Total Number of Fire and Non-Fire Incidents



Total Number of False Alarms and Good Intent Calls

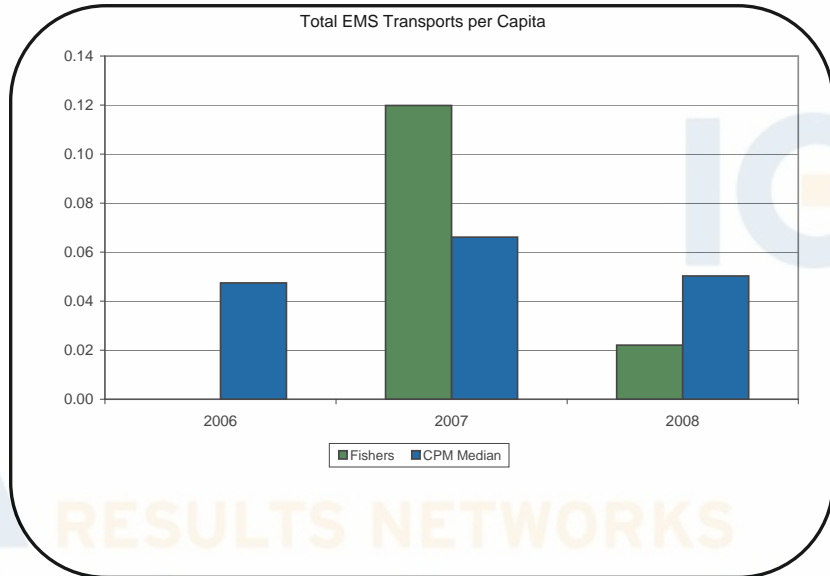
