# Make data accessible.

The weighty, multi-hundred-page printed budget book has been the standard for decades. After all, what alternatives were there?

The typical printed budget book tends to be the output of hundreds of hours of work and results from a disorganized, cross-departmental endeavor assembling disparate data and graphs from dozens of Excel spreadsheets which are cut and pasted into a Word document with written content that is wrangled into a hard-to-read printed PDF.

Although PDFs never go out of style, there's still lots of room for improvement. The budget book should be an accessible communication device that shares organization-wide, strategic goals, and strategies that address long-term concerns and issues within the community.

**Make it easy for anyone to find the budget information they need by making it more accessible.** Once available, users can click on embedded reports to see the most up-to-date information and further drill down into the details. Accessibility also means ensuring your communications meet ADA requirements and can be translated into any language.

Suppose an agency must amend information in the published budget book or other publications. # Go where residents are.

**Just about everyone is receiving, and expecting to receive, their information online. Government is no exception.** Take the budget book and publications online to meet residents where they are. Plus, when online, it can be viewed anytime, from anywhere. This allows viewers to find the answers to their questions easily.

As an example, when the City of Ashland, OR released its online budget book, roughly 10% of its population of 22,000 viewed the online budget book (over 2,000 views). In contrast, only four people downloaded the static PDF book from the previous year.

But, to still keep the traditional version available for those who prefer it, use an online tool that easily creates a PDF version of your online budget book. In addition, consider a budget brief where viewers can get the big picture without wading through hundreds of pages, like Boulder, CO did [here](#). That way, everyone wins!
