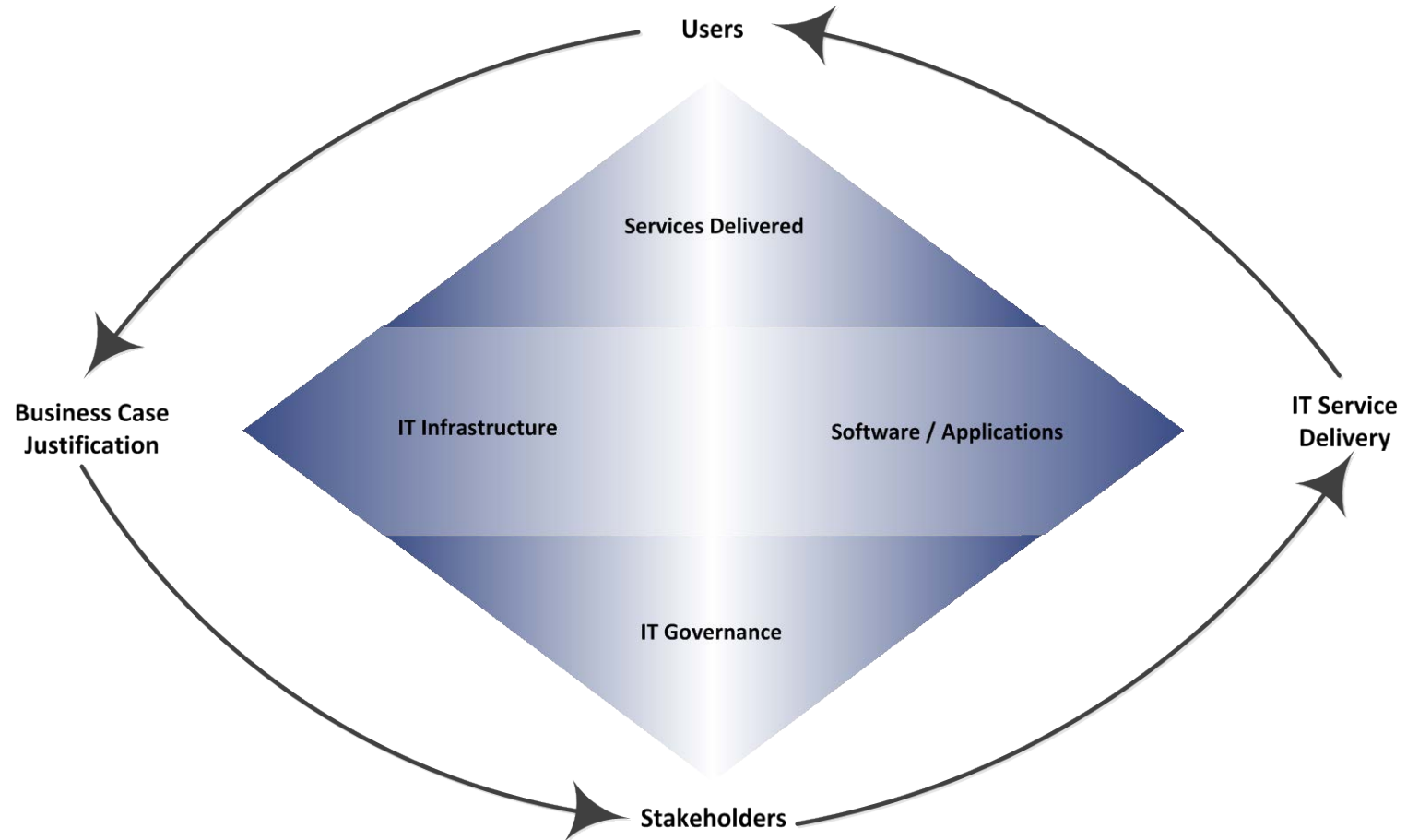


Your Takeaways Today

Government entities are experiencing a high demand for expensive IT solutions to provide required services in a cost effective manner.

- IT Strategic Planning – a tool that can stretch IT budget dollars by:
 - Defining IT goals and objectives.
 - Bringing IT to an ideal state.
 - Identifying viable strategic IT Outsource opportunities.
 - Identifying practical IT Shared Service opportunities (through inter-local agreements) within the IT Outsource opportunities.

A Fully Implemented IT Strategic Plan



IT Outsourced Services

External service providers delivering any and/or all IT-enabled application services and/or infrastructure services.

IT Outsourced Services also includes cloud based solutions.

IT Shared Services

The provision of IT services by one governmental unit/entity or group of governmental units/entities where the IT services are utilized in more than one of the units/entities.

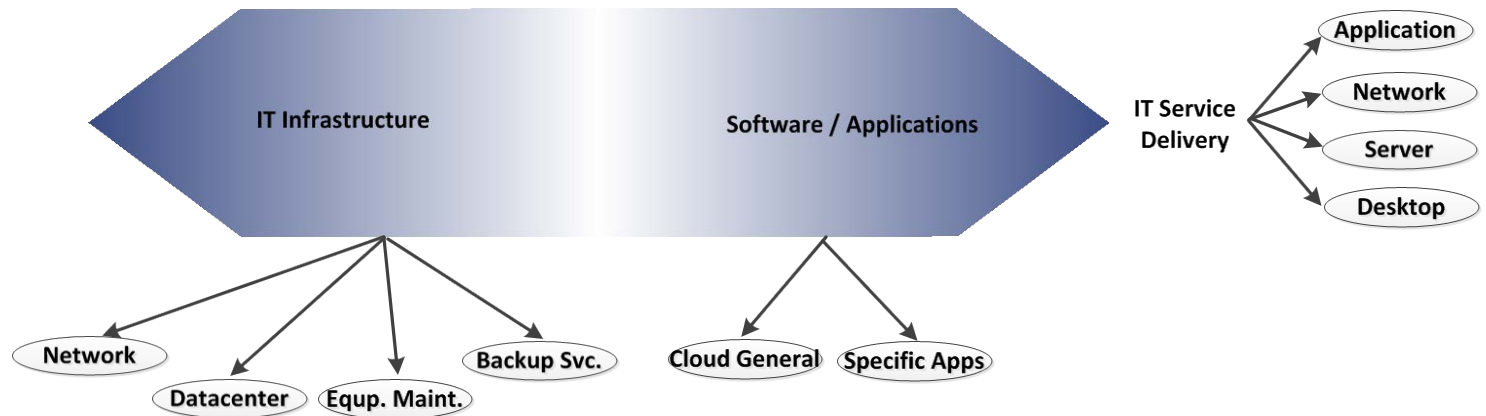
Goals for Outsourcing/Sharing Services

- Organizational cost reduction.
- Reduced implementation time.
- External expertise.
- Disaster recovery, business continuity and risk management.
- Sharing costs of expensive cutting edge technology.

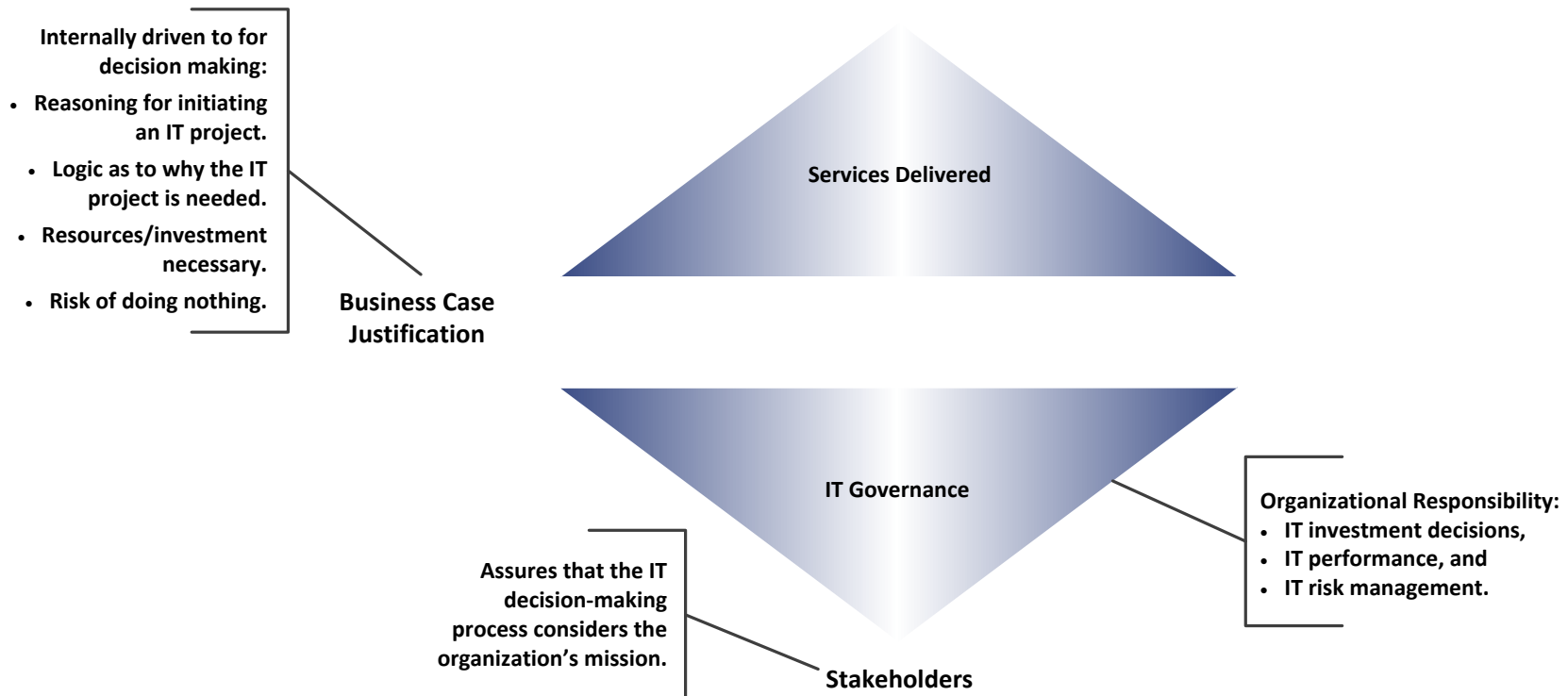

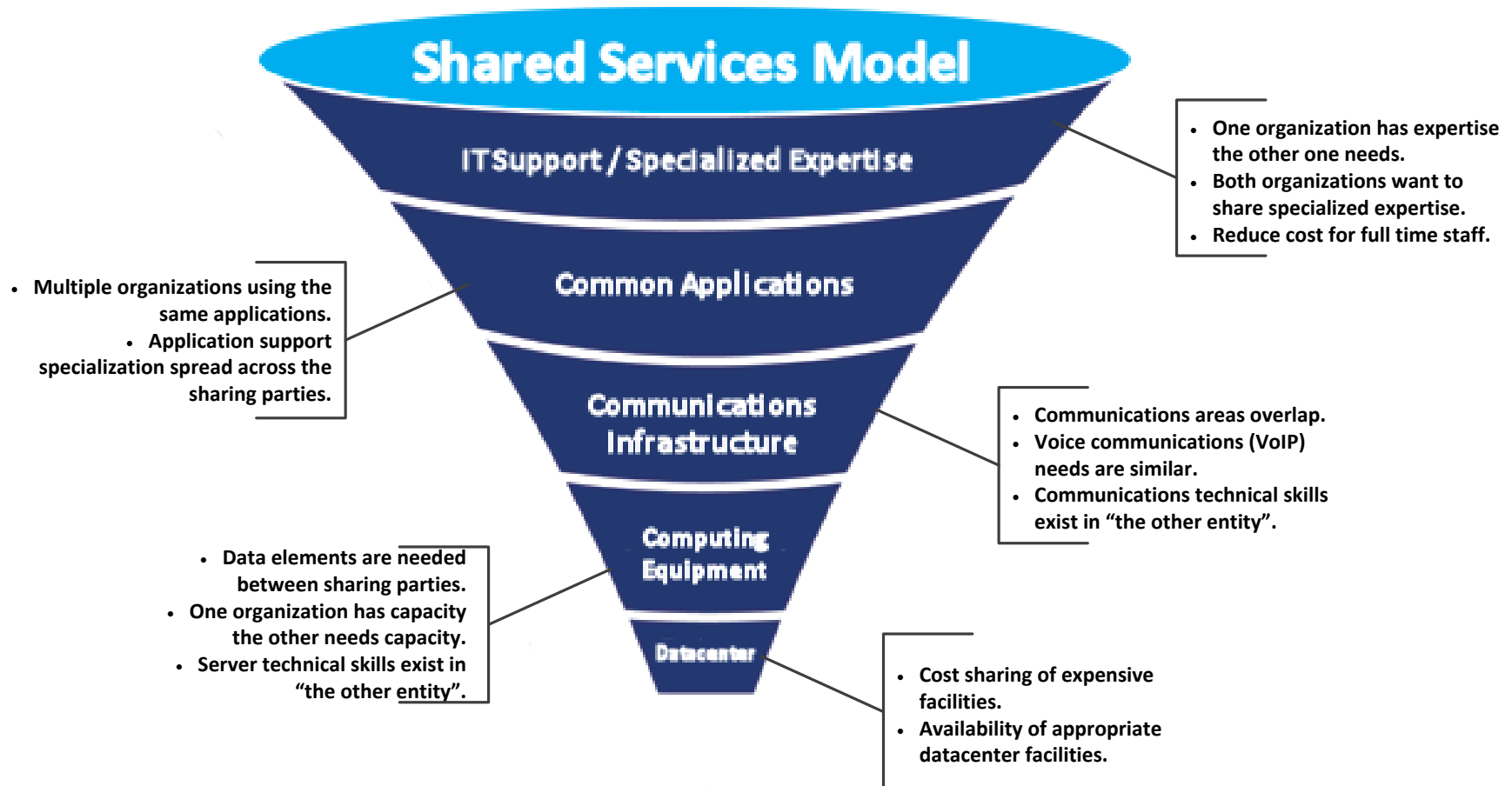
3rd Question

- Why IT outsourcing and IT shared services?
 - Reduces and controls IT operating costs.
 - Provides for IT service alignment with the organization's goals and objectives.
 - Allows the governmental entity/unit to focus on governmental services rather than IT services.
 - Shares risks with outside parties and/or others.
 - Frees resources for other purposes.
 - Frees-up funds for capital projects.
 - Augments resources not otherwise available.

4th Question

- Who should be used?
 - Choose the right partner.
 - Look for:
 - Similar work ethics.
 - Dedication.
 - Philosophy.
 - Like governmental units in proximity, size, and resources need and availability.
