exposed to the air or to view; not covered.

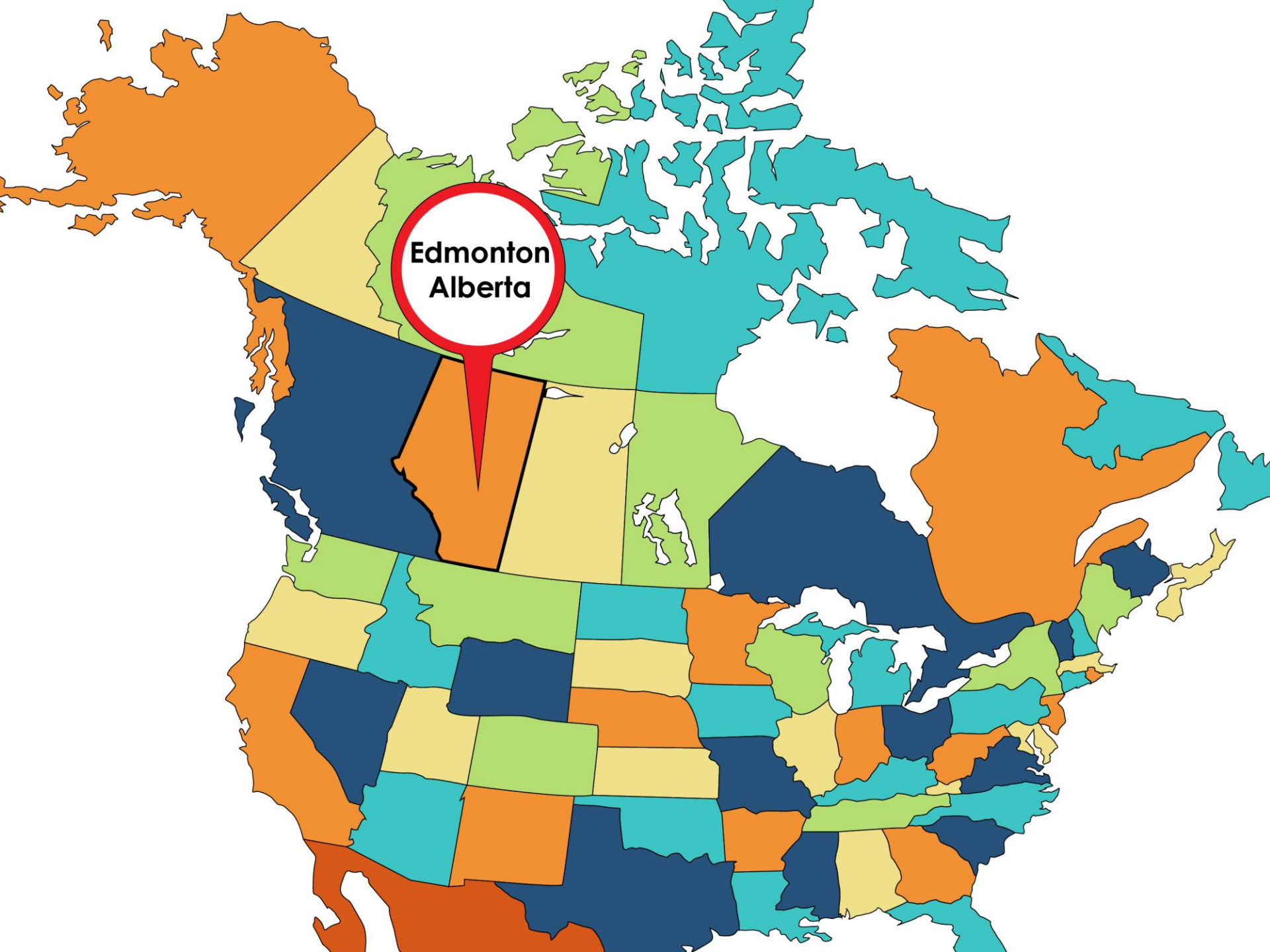

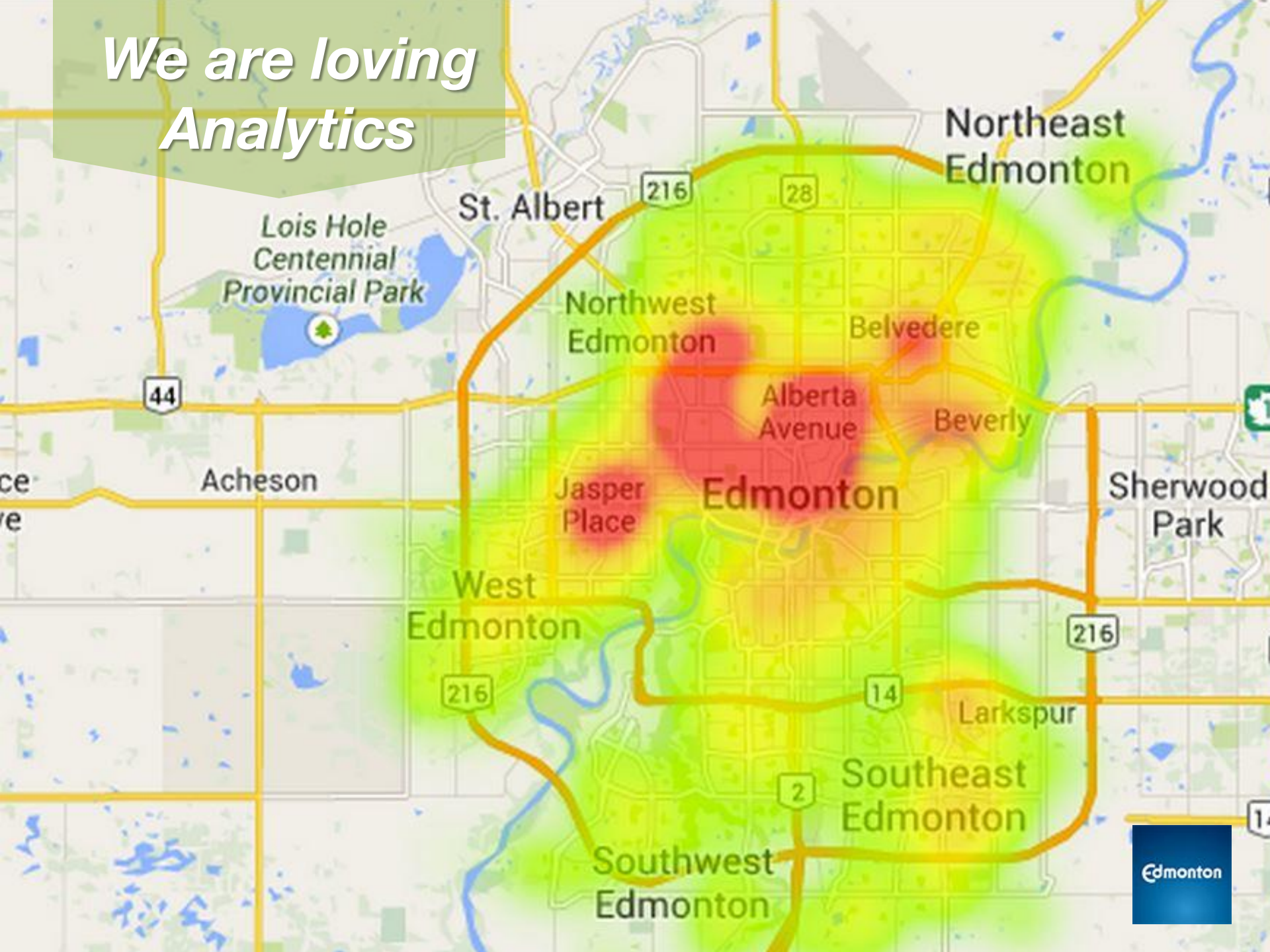
