The City of Fremont, located in southern Alameda County, stretches from the San Francisco Bay to the top of Mission Peak above historic Mission San Jose. Fremont is a culturally diverse city of over 235,000 people with an area of 90 square miles, making it the fourth most populous city in the San Francisco Bay Area and the 15th largest in California.

Fremont residents enjoy a moderate climate, high rate of home ownership and advanced education, a very low crime rate, and a quality of life that is considered to be one of the best in the United States. It is a great place to raise a family and is also strategically located in Silicon Valley just 40 miles south of San Francisco. Fremont enjoys a diverse population, with immigrants from all over the world, and is home to a wide variety of innovative high tech, life science and clean technology firms including Tesla Motors, Lam Research, Thermo Fisher Scientific, and Redwood Systems among many others. The City's Innovation District is known as the hottest new address for start-ups. Over the last two years, companies in Fremont received more than \$400 million in venture funding according to PitchBook Data.

Each 3-4 month assignment will provide practical experience implementing substantial projects in support of the City of Fremont's top initiatives such as Vision Zero, dedicated to eliminating pedestrian fatalities, or contributing to the City's robust efforts to address homelessness in our community.
